A meeting was held at the offices of WHEAS on 18<sup>th</sup> March to discuss the criteria for 'scoring' each site, as requested by Becky Burridge.

While a number of criteria were discussed it was felt that at this stage a very simply indication of a sites significance was all that is required, and that once the preferred options for the SWJCS HLA was defined, then more input would be given.

## Methodology for determining initial site significance

The two criteria for the current SWJCS HLAA can be viewed on the attribute tables of the shapefiles of Housing Land Availability provided by SWJCS.

### HE\_Statutory\_Protected

#### YES or NO

This defines whether all or part of a parcel of land listed in the HLAA contains a Statutory Protected **Scheduled Ancient Monument, Designated Parkland, registered Battlefield** or contains a **Listed Building**.

### HE\_Sensitivity

**Very High**  
**High**  
**Unknown**  
**Low**

This defines the sensitivity to development and by association the risk to the developer in terms of either development potential and or associated assessment and mitigation costs.

Sensitivity is defined by a combination of currently known Historic Environment Records and Historic Landscape Character. A transparent scoring system based on the table below is then used to determine overall Historic Environment Sensitivity at a basic level as required by this assessment.

The scoring tables for each land allocation will also be presented in a supporting document.

## **Historic Environment Record Criteria (HER)**

### **Very High.**

Site contains nationally important archaeological remains, designated parkland, registered battlefield or grade I and II\* listed building.

### **High**

Site contains, or is likely to contain, well preserved, regionally or locally significant archaeological remains based upon known or conjectural evidence.

### **Unknown**

Evidence *suggests* that the site may contain deposits or features of archaeological potential, but the currently available information is unable to define the significance and further assessment via evaluation or mitigation would be required.

### **Low**

The site can be demonstrated to be of little archaeological or landscape value. Documented evidence for the removal of deposits, by former and current mineral working, archaeological excavation or has been heavily landscaped in recent times.

## **Historic Landscape Character Criteria (HLC)**

### **Very High.**

The landscape contains a nationally designated site (Registered Parkland, Registered Battlefield or field-scale and above Scheduled Monument), or an intact historic landscape character that is not designated, but is considered by Worcestershire Historic Environment and Archaeology Service to be of national significance (e.g. a deserted settlement with associated field system).

### **High.**

The landscape has a largely intact historic character, or dominant historic elements that also relate to the landscape beyond the site, and which are considered to be of high regional or very high local significance. The landscape may contain archaeological remains, which form elements that contribute towards Historic Landscape Character significance (e.g. medieval ridge and furrow field systems).

## **Unknown**

The landscape contains surviving attributes of historic landscape value (possibly including Historic Environment Record sites), but requires further evaluation (Historic Landscape Characterisation, or rapid field survey) in order to assess and validate overall significance (e.g. poorly recorded, or predominantly wooded landscapes).

## **Low**

The historic landscape character has been significantly degraded, or lost due to recent development, or changes in land-use (e.g. industrial activity, hard landscaping or modern infrastructure associated with adjacent development).
